BACKGROUND

Drifted from art background until pursuing archeology full time under the instruction of Dr. David Jordan at the University of Chicago. There she maintained a relationship with Dr. Daniel Jackson (see files) until his departure in 1990. Continued to work with Dr. Jordan in Chicago but traveled extensively on multiple excursions outside the United States.

First established contact with SGC personnel in 1999 after the death of Dr. Jordan and investigation by Dr. Jackson. During this time Dr. Gardner was exposed to a Goa'uld symbiote hidden in a canopic jar from the Stewart Expedition. Dr. Gardner served as host to Osiris (see files) and was responsible for the death of Dr. Jordan and injuries to Dr. Steven Rayner. Osiris made his escape from Cairo, Egypt in a hidden ha'tak vessel.

Osiris later emerged as an envoy to the Goa'uld Anubis and was reinstated as a System Lord. Dr. Jackson made contact but was unable to rescue Dr. Gardner. Osiris confronted various SG teams until his capture in 2002. The Goa'uld symbiote was removed by the Tok'ra and Dr. Gardner returned to Earth for evaluation.
